



## INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARING MEDICATION FOR CAMP BARTLE



**STEP 1**

- You will need freezer and snack size resealable bags to keep your Scout's medications separate and dry.
- Labels for each bag.
- Permanent markers for labeling.



**STEP 2**

- Make up a 1 gallon freezer bag with your Scout's name and time the medication is to be given (AM, PM or as needed).
- A pre-lunch medication hand out is available by special arrangement.



**STEP 3**

- Make up one snack bag with all the medications for each day and time of camp (3 shown here).
- Each bag should be labeled with your Scout's name and time of administration. (AM/PM)
- Each one of these examples contains the 2 pills assigned for the morning.



**STEP 4**

- A card listing the medication(s) to be given
- List time they are to be given. (AM/PM)
- You MUST include the ORIGINAL prescription bottle or over-the-counter packaging



**STEP 5**

- Everything goes in the freezer bag.
- Your Scout will be given the medications as listed in their BSA Medical Form and included in the package.



**STEP 6**

- Follow the same procedure for evening medication. (PM)



**STEP 7**

- Medications that are to be used as needed can be placed in a freezer bag.



- All unused medications will be returned with your Scout.
